Speech Topic / Theme : Impromptu Speech

Objective

An impromptu speech tests your ability to think quickly, organize your thoughts, and express your ideas clearly — all on the spot.

Each participant will be given a question, prompt, or word and will deliver a 2–3 minute speech that is informative, intelligent, persuasive, or even humorous.

The goal is to show confidence, creativity, and clarity while speaking without prior preparation.

Contest Rules & Guidelines

- Contestants will enter one at a time according to the assigned speaking order.
- All other participants will remain in a separate room until their turn.
- The timer begins immediately after the question or prompt is given.
- Do not receive help — parents, friends, and other contestants are not allowed to share or hint at any questions or prompts.
- Violation of this rule may result in immediate disqualification.

Time Limit

Time Requirement: 2 to 3 minutes

(must speak for at least 2 minutes to qualify; disqualification at 3 minutes and 31 seconds).

Helpful Tips for Success

- Listen carefully to the question or prompt before speaking.
- Take a few seconds to organize your main points before you begin.
- Use a clear structure — **Opening, Body, Conclusion.**
- Speak with confidence and keep good eye contact.
- Be yourself! Let your natural humor, personality, and creativity shine through.

Impromptu speaking is about thinking fast and speaking smart!

Stay calm, stay confident, and enjoy the challenge — your voice and ideas matter.
